The Conference will be organized in the following areas:

- Current state of the Russian language and Literature in the Russian Federation, Estonia, Hungary, and Finland. Modern educational standards in teaching Russian language and Literature in the Russian Federation and foreign countries.
- Methods of forming foreign competence of students: Russian, Estonian, Hungarian, Finnish experience.
- New technologies in teaching Russian language and Literature in the Finno-Ugric area: multimedia support of the educational process, IT in teaching Russian language and Literature, methods of intensive teaching, integrative technologies, cultural comment of art texts.
- Actual problems of the methods of Russian language and Literature teaching as foreign in the light of inter-cultural communication.

- Problems of the linguo-didactic description and teaching of the Phonetics, Lexicology, Grammar for Finno-Ugric audience.
- Theory and practice of teaching of the art text for the Finno-Ugric audience.
- Theory and practice of the ICT usage in teaching of the Russian language and Literature as foreign.
- School linguo-concept: methodic and technologies of the Russian culture adaptation.
- Technology of speech and literary development of the students from the Finno-Ugric area.
- Modeling of the training text in the in the practice of teaching Russian language and Literature in the Finno-Ugric area: choosing of the content, principals of the structure, and technologies of its learning.
- Organization of the research and project activities in the practice of the Russian language and Literature teaching at school and universities.
- Modeling of the innovative educational programs in the practice of teaching Literature and Russian language as foreign.
- Technology of improving professional competence of the Russian language and Literature teacher in the bi-lingual and multi-lingual audience.
- Technologies of the preparing for the State Exam in Russian.
- Value-conscious potential of Russian Literature in the multiethnic and multireligious Russian society.

The Conference will be organized in the form of round tables, panel discussions, sections and plenary meeting.

During the round tables, we are planning to discuss following issues:

- 1) Forming of the multicultural identity in the process of the dialog of cultures as the factor of educational modernization.
- 2) Cognitive technologies of the Russian language and Literature teaching in double-language and multi-language as the factor of education modernization.
- 3) Technologies of acquisition of the specific national concepts of Russian culture in the practice of Russian language and Literature teaching.
- 4) Russian Language in the Internet.

During the Conference we are planning to hold 2 workshops:

1. ICT in the practice of Russian language and Literature teaching as foreign and non-mother language.
2. Translation as the means of intercultural understanding. Computer translation.

The requirements for article formatting:

1. Article length shall be 6 pages (A4) maximum; fields: left field – 3 cm, right, top and bottom – 2 cm; printing type – Times New Roman; type size – 14 points; line spacing – one-and-a half.
2. The article shall be provided in the electronic form in Microsoft Word; the name of the file is determined as the first author's surname (e.g.: surname.doc). This article is provided together with the Application.
3. Drawings and photos should be black-and-white and should be duplicated in the form of the independent files (each in separate file). The picture resolution should be not less than 300 pixels/inch. Pictures and tables shall be enumerated and have titles (e.g.: the results of research are shown in the table №2). The name of the picture and the comments shall be presented under it, the title of the table – above it. All the Latin scripts in the text shall be in italics: *sin*, *cos*, *tg*, *ctg*, *exp*, *In*, *const*, *min*, *max*, *Pr*, *Re*. All the Greek scripts and special symbols shall be printed in Roman Type. Math expressions and formulas shall be printed in the new lines and shall be separated by the empty lines before and after the formulae.
4. The list of the references shall be made as a separate section at the end of the article. The sources shall be listed in order of their citation in the article. Reference to the source in the text shall be printed as a number in square brackets (E.g.: [1])
5. The information about the author (authors) of the article shall be attached. Required information: family name, name, place of employment, position with the

indication of the department, chair, laboratory, etc., a scientific degree, title, phone number, e-mail.
